- 7:10 pm** March into the Stadium. Get hyped!!!
- 7:15 pm** Pre-Game Performance on the field. Fight Songs / National Anthem
- 7:30 pm** Kickoff, perform in the stands with the band.
- 8:15 pm** Travel to our 2nd Quarter Warm Up. Observe the band in action. (Parents are encouraged to attend).
- 8:45 pm** Watch our jazz/funk themed competitive halftime show entitled “Cityscapes”.
- 9:00 pm** Students and Parents meet with current Crimson Sound members, parents and Mr. Gregory behind the home stands. Students are welcome to stay for the remainder of the game or may be dismissed. *The Manual Band Staff must see you leave with an adult.*

All participating Middle School students will receive FREE admission to the game. (Students MUST have an adult present during the game—no drop offs please). Students will also receive a free duPont Manual Band t-shirt courtesy of the Manual Band Parents, Inc. Adult game tickets are \$7. Please do not mail in money. (Pay \$7 cash at the gate). Parking admission is \$5. Parking outside of the stadium is free. The Stadium Address is 1230 East Burnett Ave, Louisville, KY 40208.

***Attire— Students, please wear a plain red t-shirt or golf shirt and black pants. Any type of tennis shoe or loafer is fine. Shirts should be tucked in with a belt.**

Supplies – *Students are responsible for bringing their own instrument, reeds and mouthpieces.

Percussionists need to bring a pair of snare drum sticks. Music stands WILL be provided but please put your music in a 1/2” binder with plastic sleeves prior to arriving at the stadium. Also get a few binder clips in case there is wind. Another option is to purchase a flip folder and lyre from our local music shops (Mel Owen Music or Music & Arts). Limited Marching Drums will be the only instruments provided. Tubists and Hornists may try out our sousaphones and mellophones throughout the evening but still need to bring their own instrument. Students interested in color guard will be supplied with a flag.
